FAQ

How soon can a learner receive materials prior to sitting an exam?

For the online training materials, once they have payed, they will be given a link and a password which will be allocated by UK staff. All of the materials are contained on our virtual academy which they may download.

What is the minimum period?

Students are given access for a period of 60 days for the online learning but extensions can be applied depending on the situation at the time.

What is the required minimum classroom attendance required for each course?

The 3.1 Bridging is designed to deliver 3 days of training. The student will be required to attend a 2 day's classroom practical event followed by a 1 day examination. Completion of the online course plays a critical part to ensure you are well prepared for the classroom training and examinations.

What is the minimum number of learners required to attend examinations? We require a minimum of 8 bookings.

Do the candidates get hard copies of course notes and can we issue them prior to classroom attendance? We do not provide a hard copy; a copy can be printed from the PDF.

What do I need to bring with for the exam?

- Vision certificate (reading a minimum of Times Roman N4.5, or equivalent type and size letters, at not less than 300mm on a standard test chart for near vision, in at least one eye, corrected or uncorrected) Please use the Vision Test attached.
- 2 passport size photographs (Name and signature behind).

Entry Requirements

Needs to hold a current SAIW Welding/Fabricator Inspector Level 1 and sit an examination consisting of:

- General paper 30 multiple choice questions, time allowed 45 minutes
- Technical paper 60 multiple choice guestions, time allowed 90 minutes
- Macro, 24 multiple choice questions, time allowed 45 minutes
- Pipe, 20 multiple choice questions, plus practical, time allowed 105 minutes

Note: There is no bridging for the following qualifications: PCN and SAIW IWIP Basic Diploma
