This course is designed for holders of a SAIW Level 2 Welding Inspector qualification wishing to upgrade to the internationally recognised CSWIP qualification.

### What will I learn?

Welding technology; NDT reports; fracture failures; weld symbols on engineering drawings.

The course and exam package is designed to prepare you for the CSWIP Welding Inspector bridging examination.

### FAQ

#### How soon can a learner receive materials prior to sitting an exam?

For the online training materials, once they have payed, they will be given a link and a password which will be allocated by TWI UK staff. All of the materials are contained on our virtual academy which they may download.

#### What is the minimum period?

Students are given access for a period of 60 days for the online learning but extensions can be applied depending on the situation at the time.

#### What is the required minimum classroom attendance required for each course?

The 3.2 Bridging is designed to deliver 2 days of classroom training. The student will be required to attend a 1 day classroom practical event followed by a one day examination. Completion of the online course plays a critical part to ensure you are well prepared for the classroom training and examinations.

#### What is the minimum number of learners required to attend examinations?

We only require a minimum of 8 bookings

#### Do the candidates get hard copies of course notes and can we issue them prior to classroom attendance?

We do not provide a hard copy; a copy can be printed from the PDF.

#### What do I need to bring with for the exam?

- Vision certificate (reading a minimum of Times Roman N4.5, or equivalent type and size letters, at not less than 300mm on a standard test chart for near vision, in at least one eye, corrected or uncorrected) Please use the Vision Test attached.
- 2 passport size photographs (Name and signature behind).

In order to qualify for this course you need to hold a current SAIW Welding/Fabricator Inspector 2

- Examination of weld failures (Practical Part B3), time allowed 60 minutes
- Scrutiny of fabrication drawings (Practical Part C3), time allowed 60 minutes
